






Statement of authors

This statement is written for the purpose of publishing the scientific article: "THE USE OF HYALURONIC AND AMINOCAPROIC ACID IN THE TREATMENT OF ALVEOLAR OSTEITIS" by Dejan Dubovina, Branko Mihailovic, Zoran Bukumiric, Zoran Vlahovic, Milan Miladinovic and Zoran Lazic in the Vojnosanitetski preglad.

This prospective randomized clinical study included 60 patients with clinical diagnosis of alveolar osteitis – a most common complication that occurs after permanent tooth extraction. Although the etiology and the pathogenesis of this post extraction healing disorder has been thoroughly examined, the therapy of alveolar osteitis remains palliative. In this study we explored if hyaluronic and aminocaproic acid can be used in the treatment of alveolar osteitis and compared two non-pharmacological therapeutic procedures – alveolar irrigation and curettage. We find the results very interesting and believe that this study should be presented to scientific community.
